- 3.6 The quantities mentioned in the tender document are approximate. The tender accepting authority shall be permitted to vary the quantities finally ordered and execute the work through the contractor to the extent of 25% (Twenty five percent) either way of the requirements.
- 3.7 **Go through the check slip given and ensure compliance of the terms and conditions.**
- 3.8 The tenderer is specifically informed that all the pages in both Part I – Technical Bid and part II – Commercial Bid should be signed at the bottom of each page without any omission by the authorized signatory with name and seal of the firm. The signatory of the tender should indicate his/their status in which he/they have signed and submit necessary documentary

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proof admissible in law in respect of such authority assigned to him/them by the firm.

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4.0.GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

4.1. Tender under sealed **two part tender system** (i.e.) Technical Bid (Pre-qualification) & Price Bid are invited by the Joint Managing Director, TCMPPF Ltd. for the [Supply of 303 Nos. of Various Capacities Road Milk Tankers on Hire for Transportation of Milk From/To DCMPU Dairies/Chilling Centers/Bulk Milk Coolers of Tamilnadu /Andhrapradesh / Karnataka/ Kerala / Telangana States and Other Dairies for the Period of 3 Years 2019-2022.](#)

4.2.1.The tenderer should be an operator/contractor of road milk tankers.

4.2.2.Milk is a perishable commodity and handling it requires experience. Hence the Tenderers shall have minimum 2 years' experience with in the last 7 year period in milk tanker operation in a District unions/ Federation of TamilNadu. The Tender should be in the same name as the bidding entity. The seven year period will be calculated proceeding from the date of publication of notice inviting tender.The tenderer should submit valid documents to prove his experience in transporting milk.

4.3.

4.3.1 PART I TECHNICAL BID, wherein the pre-qualification, based on various factors such as supply, capacity etc., suitability and eligibility of the tenderer will be evaluated, considered and decided prior to opening of commercial Bids under PART II of the tender.

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- 4.3.2. THE PART I technical bid shall be opened on **10.10.2019 at 2.30 P.M.** in the presence of the tenderers or their authorized representative who opt to be present during the opening.
- 4.4.
- 4.4.1. The PART II Commercial Bid of the tenderers who do not satisfy any/all the terms and conditions specifically so mentioned under PART I technical bid, shall not be considered and shall not be opened as non responsive.
- 4.4.2. PART II Commercial Bid, wherein the rates tendered by those who qualify for and are selected as per the terms and conditions prescribed in PART I TECHNICAL BID only will be considered and decided for the award of the contract for the [Supply of 303 Nos. of Various Capacities Road Milk Tankers on Hire for Transportation of Milk From / To DCMPU Dairies / Chilling Centers / Bulk Milk Coolers of Tamilnadu /Andhrapradesh / Karnataka/ Kerala / Telangana States and Other Dairies for the Period of 3 Years 2019-2022.](#)
- 4.5. The Part II commercial bids shall normally be opened within 60 days from the date of opening of the Part I pre-qualification/ technical bid in the presence of tenderers or their authorized representatives who opt to be present. The date of such opening of commercial bid will be informed separately to those who qualify in the PART I technical bid.
- 4.6. The tenderer is specifically informed that all the pages in both Part I – Technical Bid and Part II – Commercial Bid should be signed at the bottom of each page without any omission by the authorized signatory with name and seal of the firm.

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- 4.7. The tender forms are not transferable or assignable.
- 4.8. The signatory of the tender should indicate his/their status in which he/they have signed and submit necessary documentary proof admissible in law in respect of such authority assigned to him/them by the firm. If the tender opening day is declared as a holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened immediately on the next working day at the same time and place.
- 4.9. If the tender opening day is declared as a holiday, the tenders shall be received and opened immediately on the next working day at the same time and place.
- 4.10. The Tamilnadu Cooperative Milk Producers' Federation Ltd will not accept any variations in conditions stipulated in the tender.
- 4.11. Any suggestion in the tender, for any modification of the tender conditions will not be entertained and the conditional offer will render the tender invalid.
- 4.12. The tenderer can attend the pre bid meeting where the clarifications/queries can be raised by the tenderer and the minutes of the meeting with corrigendum/modifications, if any, will be uploaded in the website.
- 4.13. The contract period for road milk tanker is three years from the date of awarding of contract.

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4.14 E.M.D. PAYABLE:

4.14.1 The tender shall be accompanied by an EMD @ Rs. 10,000.00 - per R.M.T, as Demand Draft drawn on a Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank in favour of "The Joint Managing Director, TCMPPF Ltd." payable at Chennai.**IT SHALL BE ENCLOSED WITH THE PART I TECHNICAL BID ONLY. No other form of remittance shall be accepted.**

4.14.2 If the application is made on-line, **the EMD should be dropped in the tender box before the closure time.**

4.14.3 SSI Units claiming exemption from the payment of EMD,

1. Shall enclose a copy of the documentary proof/evidence such as EM Part – II as per MSMED Act 2006/ Udyog Aadhar Certificate for SSI Certificate in the technical bid for tenderers from the state of Tamilnadu, in respect of which tenders have been called for alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD.
2. In respect of SSI units located outside the state of Tamilnadu, such of these units registered with NSIC Certificate in respect of which tenders have been called for alone will be granted exemption from payment of EMD.

4.14.4 Tenders not accompanied with demand draft towards the prescribed EMD or the relevant documentary proof for the exemption thereon shall be summarily rejected.

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4.14.5 FORFEITURE OF EMD:

- 1.If the Tenderer, for any reason, withdraws his offer (or) stipulates any conditions in his offer;
- 2.If the tenderer submits fresh offer/revises offers in case of any omission subsequently after opening;
- 3.If the tenderer backs off before the expiry of validity period or after acceptance of Works Contract;
- 4.If the tenderer revises any of the terms quoted during the validity period

4.14.6. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

4.14.6.1. No Tenderer shall be allowed to withdraw the tenders after submitting the tender.

4.14.6.2. A Tenderer may submit a modified Tender before the last date for receipt of tender:

Provided that where more than one Tender is submitted by the same Tenderer, the lowest eligible financial tender shall be considered for evaluation.

4.14.6.3. Each Tenderer modification notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked and delivered with the outer and inner envelopes additionally marked MODIFICATION as appropriate.

4.14.6.4. No bid may be modified after the deadline for submission of Bids.

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- 4.14.7. Tenderers shall submit offers that comply with the requirements of the bidding documents, as indicated in the technical specifications. **“Alternatives will not be considered”**.
- 4.14.8. Communication to the unsuccessful Tenderers will be sent after the communication sent to the successful Tenderers. Within 90 (Ninety) days from the date of the receipt of refund vouchers duly stamped and signed from the unsuccessful Tenderers, refund of Earnest Money Deposit will be made.

Permit suitable for all kinds of goods and milk and milk products except hazard vehicles.

However, R.C. book shall be submitted immediately on the date of inspection. Grace time of 7 days will be given from the date of award of contract for submitting the FSSAI certificate, Road tax, Fitness certificate, Insurance and Permit.

4.15.6. The R.C. Books of the RMTs shall be in the name of the tenderer in the case of sole owner. If the tenderer is in any partnership in force, R.C. Book shall be in the name of either the firm or one of the partners and in the case of companies the R.C. Book shall be in the name of the company (or) in the name of Director (or) duly authorized person on behalf of the company. In the case of Co-operative societies, the RC book shall be in the name of society or in the name of member of the society.

4.15.7. Provided an individual who is a sole owner and or partner in more than one firm and or a director of a company or companies and or a member of Co-Operative society or societies, having RC Books in his name shall offer his tender only in respect of any one of the above institutions viz. proprietary or firm or company or co-operative society.

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4.15.8. The tenderer should enclose the copy of the deed / agreement or other documentary evidence under statute to show that he is the sole owner/ Partner of a firm/ Director of the company / member of co-operative society.

4.15.9. The documents submitted should be genuine and reflect the correct position as the tender accepting authority is guided by the documents filed by the tenderer. If any document of the successful tenderer is found to be bogus or false, apart from terminating the contract penal action will be taken for collecting liquidated damages from the tenderer.

4.16. AGE OF THE ROAD TANKER:

The RMTs shall be in road worthy condition and its age must be lesser than 12 years as on the date of publication of notice inviting tender. The age of the vehicle will be calculated from the date of first registration of the RMT.

4.17. SECURITY DEPOSIT

Each successful Tenderer, before execution of the agreement shall furnish a Demand Draft from a Nationalized Bank / Scheduled Bank drawn in favor of the General Manager of the concerned Union payable at places specified, at the rate of Rs. 75,000/- per 8.5 KL RMT and Rs.1,00,000/- per 15 KL RMT as Security Deposit to the Union or the successful tenderer shall furnish irrevocable bank guarantee for a period of three years for the above security amount value . In the event of extension of contract period, the successful Tenderer shall extend the bank guarantee period to the extent of extension of contract period. The EMD paid shall be adjusted against the Security Deposit payable to the Union.

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No exemption will be given from payment of Security deposit under any circumstances as per TTTT Act and the same should be remitted by Demand Draft/ Bank guarantee .Any other form of remittance will not be accepted.

4.17.1. The security deposit will be refunded only after the expiry of 6 months from the date of satisfactory completion of the contract satisfactorily complying to the and subject to the production of original receipt.

4.17.2.No interest will be paid on the Security Deposit.

4.18. AGREEMENT: The successful Tenderer shall execute an agreement with the Concerned Union on Rs.100/- valued Non-judicial Stamp Paper incorporating the terms and conditions of the contract within fifteen days from the date intimation of the acceptance of the tender.

In case of default of either of the conditions (i.e) remitting the security deposit or execution of the agreement within the time allowed, the EMD paid is likely to be forfeited.

4.18.1. If the contractor fails to execute the contract satisfactorily at the tendered rate, the security deposit will be forfeited.

4.18.2. If the Union incurs any loss / additional expenditure due to the negligence of the contractor in connection with the work during the period of contract, the same shall be recovered together with all charges and expenses from the contractor.

4.18.3. The breakages or damages, if any, caused by the contractor to the property of the Union/Federation, the cost will be recovered from the contractor.

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4.18.4. No interest shall be paid on Earnest Money Deposit/Security Deposit.

4.19. PAYMENT TERMS:

4.19.1. Payment will be made against claims along with the necessary documents like duplicate copy of Weightment slip, Trip sheet, Tollgate fee receipts in original.

4.19.2. Such payment will be made within 15 days from the date of such claims by the contractor excluding the deductions/ penalties/recoveries/ statutory deduction as applicable.

N.B: NO OTHER TERMS OF PAYMENT WILL BE ENTERTAINED.

4.20. PENALTY CLAUSE:

4.20.1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the tender schedule, no obligation rests on the Federation to accept the lowest tender and the Federation shall also have the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders fully or partly without assigning any reasons.

4.20.2. For violation of any of the terms and conditions of the contract, the Concerned Union reserves the right to terminate the contract, with or without notice as applicable.

4.20.3. On termination of contract, the Security Deposit is liable to be forfeited and any of the resultant loss beyond Security Deposit will be recovered from the contractor by legal means apart from forfeiture of any amount due to the contractor.

4.20.4 (a). If the tenderer defaulted in any of the previous tenders within a period 3 years to execute agreement or to pay Security Deposit or to

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supply ordered quantity either in part or full will not be eligible from participating in this tender.

- (b). If the successful tenderer either in TCMPF or in the DCMPU defaulted to execute agreement or to pay Security Deposit or to supply ordered quantity either in part or full shall be debarred from participating in the subsequent tenders for a period of 3 years.

4.21. FORCE MAJEURE:

Failure or delay in the part of contractor for operation of tankers due to force majeure causes enumerated here under shall be considered, provided the supplier produces documentary evidence.

- a. Any cause which is beyond the reasonable control of the contractor.
- b. Natural phenomena, such as floods, drought, earthquakes and epidemics.
- c. Act of any Govt. Authority, domestic or foreign, such as wars declared or undeclared quarantines, embargoes licensing control on production or distribution restrictions.
- d. Accident and disruptions such as fire, explosion, increase in power cut with respect to date of tender opening etc.,
- e. Strikes, slow down and lockouts.

The cause of force majeure condition will be taken into consideration only if the supplier notifies within 30 days from the occurrence of such eventualities. The purchaser shall verify the facts and grant such extension as the facts justify. For extension due to force majeure conditions, the

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supplier shall submit his representation with documentary evidence for scrutiny by the purchaser and decision of the purchaser shall be binding on the time.

4.22. DISPUTES AND ARBITRATION:

In case of disputes arising out of this tender, an arbitrator as mutually acceptable to the tenderer and Federation will be appointed by the Managing Director, TCMF Limited. The arbitrator's decision shall be final, conclusive and binding on both the parties.

4.23. LEGAL JURISDICTION

In case if either party to the tender is aggrieved by the award of the arbitrator so appointed as per clause 4.22 or otherwise, they can appeal to Court of Deputy Registrar (Dairying), Thiruvallur. The legal jurisdiction will be only Deputy Registrar (Dairying), Thiruvallur Court.

4.24.FINALIZATION OF TENDER

4.24.1.After opening the Technical Bid, the eligible tenderers will be called for the commercial Bid opening.

4.24.2.The Tenderer shall quote his rate which shall include all operating expenses (direct and indirect), permit charges, wages, vehicle insurance, Cargo insurance, Tollgate fee etc. for transporting 8.5 KL /15 KL of milk.

4.24.3.The price of diesel prevailing at Chennai on the date of publication of notice inviting tender will be taken for evaluation of the rates offered by the tenderers.

4.24.4.The rates quoted will remain firm throughout the period of contract. Once the contract is awarded to the tenderer, the charges payable to the

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tenderer for the work extended will be only at the rate accepted and finalized by the Federation. Even during extension of contract period, the tenderer will be paid the same tender approved rate. The tenderer can not claim any extra amount on this account.

4.24.5. However the contract rate will be adjusted for any variations in the price of diesel occurring subsequent to the date of publication of notice inviting tender. The increase/decrease in rate will be based on MRP of HSD sold by public sector oil companies, in Madhavaram, Chennai and mileage will be calculated as follows

8.5 KL- 5.00 KM per Litre

15 KL - 4.75 KM per Litre

4.25. TOLLGATE CHARGES:

While quoting the rates in the Part-II Commercial Bid, the Toll rate charges shall be executed.

The Toll charges shall be reimbursed 'On actuals' basis on production of relevant original toll fee receipts to the Union.

4.26. PARTNERSHIP DEED:

Tenders will be accepted from Partnership firms only if there is a Partnership deed between the tenderers atleast one year prior to the date of notification calling for tender. Partnership deed enter into by the contractors within one year prior to the date of notification calling for tender and subsequent to it will not be entertained under any circumstances and will be liable to disqualification.

4.27.INSPECTION OF ROAD MILK TANKERS:

- 4.27.1.RMTs are subject to inspection by the General Manager of the Union or by any Officer authorized/nominated by him at any time. Maximum time allowed for producing the allotted vehicle by the successful Tenderer is 15 days from the date of receipt of Work order. If any defects are noticed at the time of production of vehicle, the same will have to be rectified by the successful Tenderer immediately.
- 4.27.2.If the RMTs provided by the Contractor are in bad condition / found to be unfit for milk transportation it shall be disengaged and the tenderer shall make immediate alternative arrangement for milk transportation so as to avoid any dislocation in milk movement.
- 4.27.3.The successful tenderer should provide only road-worthy vehicles for the contractual work. In case of development of sudden defect and the Contractor should get the vehicle repaired immediately.
- 4.27.4.In case of plying such defective vehicle the Contractor should immediately inform the Union and the tenderer will be paid hire charges less by 5% per trip till it is rectified. However such vehicle should not be used beyond 30 days. If such vehicles are used beyond 30 days, the contract of that vehicle will be terminated, forfeiting the Security Deposit and levying liquidated damages.
- 4.27.5.If the Contractor fails to inform the Union about the use of defective vehicle and if the Union comes to know of that, the Union shall issue notice to the contractor to rectify the defect within 15 days of receipt of notice. If the contractor fails to rectify the defects pointed out within 15

days of receipt of notice, the Union reserves the right to terminate the contract of the vehicle and levy appropriate damages.

4.27.6. In case the Contractor could not discharge his contractual obligation because of the above reason and also could not make alternative arrangement for uninterrupted work of transportation of milk, the Union would levy penalty and additional damages for such failure of the tenderer.

4.27.7. The Contractor shall display the following items in size specified by the Federation on the tankers at their cost.

- i. 'AAVIN' logo on front and back.
- ii. 'On Contract' with the concerned DCMPU Ltd. name on both the sides of tanker
- iii. Contractor's name and mobile number.

4.27.8. The Tenderer should remit Rs.10 /- and become the associate member of the Union on awarding of the contract. The amount will not be refunded and the tenderer is not eligible for participating in election or getting the profit.

4.27.9. The employees of Federation / District Co operative Milk Producers' Union / Milk Producers' Co operative Society / Milk Consumers Co operative Society / Dairy Development Department or their family members cannot participate in the tender in any form.

Here, the term "Family member" means, Spouse, Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Son, Daughter, Grand Father, Grand Mother, Son in Law, Daughter in Law, Grandson and Grand Daughter.

4.28. TRANSIT INSURANCE:

The Contractor shall arrange for insuring the cost of milk transported in the RMT (Cargo Insurance). The loss sustained to the Union on account of spoilage of milk due to delays in transportation, variance in quality / quantity of milk transported due to tampering of seal and other damages occurring to the property of the Union, milk societies etc. due to the negligence of the Contractor or his crew, will be recovered from the Contractor.

4.29. RIGHTS OF THE CONTRACTEE:

- i. The Union reserves the right to allot the route to be operated from anyone of the Dairy / Chilling Centres / BMC Centres / other states as and when necessitated for un-interrupted transportation of milk. The routes and the number of BMCs attached are liable to be changed by the General Manager / authorized officers of the Union in case of exigencies and it will be the bounden duty of the tenderer to follow the directions. In such cases, the tenderer will be paid transportation charges at the approved rate applicable for the said routes.
- ii. The RMTs shall not be used for transporting any item including milk for other Unions / organisations during their return trip. If any vehicle is found indulging in these activities the contract will be terminated without giving notice.
- iii. The allotted RMTs shall be used for the purpose of milk transportation of the Union only. No person other than the driver, attender and the authorized employee of the Union shall be allowed to travel in the RMTs within the permissible limit prescribed in the MV Act .

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SIGNATURE OF THE TENDERER

4.30.OBLIGATIONS OF THE CONTRACTOR:

- a) The RMTs shall be ready for operation for the entire period of contract other than for F.C. repairs for which a maximum of 30 days will be given for getting F.C. During the period of F.C. repairs the tenderer is duty bound to provide alternate tanker and to ensure that there is no interruption of the scheduled operations. During the period when the permission was availed by the tenderer to garage the RMT, the tenderer should ensure uninterrupted contractual operations by providing substitute RMT conforming to all specifications stipulated in the tender document. There should be no deficiency in service or damage on any count, because of engaging substituted vehicle. In the absence of such substituted vehicle while the contracted RMT is garaged, the tenderer shall pay to the Union, the loss if any suffered by the Union plus a fine of Rs. 1000/- per day. The request of Contractor seeking permission to garage the RMT for a period up to 30 days for carrying out fitness certification job will be considered only if the requests are received at least 30 days in advance.
- b) The allotted RMTs shall not be sold / disposed off or leased out to others during the contract period. However the tenderer is permitted to sell / dispose the allotted RMT during the contract period after getting prior permission from the General Manager of the Union, provided he offers an alternative RMT of similar capacity and age lesser than the tendered RMT.
- c) The successful tenderers / vehicle crews are supposed to transport the milk from dairies and delivery at respective locations as per the

Delivery Schedule. The vehicle should not indulge in transportation of any other items / products.

- d) The tenderer shall provide replacement of tendered RMT in case of accident and unforeseen circumstances. In the event of accident / breakdown en route, it is the responsibility of the successful tenderer to make alternative arrangements to decant milk from RMTs and transport milk safely to the destination. During this process there should not be any wastage or spoilage of milk. In case of wastage / spoilage due to the above event, the loss will be recovered as assessed by the Union from the Contractor.
- e) In the above events, the tenderer shall provide replacement for tendered RMT of same capacity. If higher capacity vehicles are provided, the rate applicable for the tendered vehicle alone will be paid.
- f) The successful tenderer should operate the RMT in case of necessity as per the agreement beyond tender period up to the time permitted by the TTTT Rule 14(9), at the same rate, terms and conditions.
- g) The tenderer shall arrange to provide the required number of additional RMTs within the limit permitted in the TTTT rule 14(9) at required time and at required place as per the direction of General Manager of the Union or his authorized representative at the same contract rate only.

4.31.GLOBAL POSITIONING SYSTEM (GPS):

- a) The concerned Union will fit and maintain GPS instrument in all Road Milk Tankers (RMT).
- b) The contractors should not tamper or damage the GPS instrument, if it is tampered or damaged, then the penalty clause will be invoked.
- c) The Road Milk Tanker will be engaged only, if the GPS is functioning.
- d) The contractor should not operate the vehicle, if GPS instrument does not function or is malfunctioning.
- e) The above GPS clause will come into force from the date of commissioning of GPS.

4.32.PENALTY CLAUSE FOR BREAKDOWN OF GPS INSTRUMENTS:

- a) If the GPS instrument is damaged double, the cost of the GPS instrument will be recovered as penalty from the contractor besides disengaging the vehicle crew permanently.
- b) If the above lapse is repeated for second time, the contract for the above Road Milk Tanker (RMT) will be suspended for 15 days, besides imposing penalty as mentioned above.
- c) If the above lapse is repeated for third time, the contract for the above RMT will be terminated permanently without giving any notice.
- d) If the GPS instrument is removed from the RMT, damage to the antenna, removal of main battery wire, damage to SIM Card etc., or any other incidence which leads to non -functioning of GPS instrument will attract a penalty of Rs. 2,000/- to the contractor for

the first occasion and Rs. 5,000/- for the second occasion besides disengaging the vehicle crew permanently and the Union reserves the right to terminate the contract permanently without giving any notice.

4.33. FSSAI CERTIFICATE:

The FSSAI Certificate from the competent authority must be provided by the successful tenderer within 7 days from the date of award of the contract. Such Certificate must be valid throughout the period of contract and it is the responsibility of the contractor to renew the certificate.

4.34. LIABILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TOWARDS HIS EMPLOYEES:

- a) The relationship between the Union and the Contractor is one of principal to principal and not one of principal to agent.
- b) The Contractor is obliged to discharge the contractual obligation by engaging his own men and materials. The Union will have no connection whatsoever with the men engaged by the tenderer.
- c) The Contractor is liable for implementation of all applicable laws including labour laws. The contractor shall register under the EPF Act, and ESI Act etc., The contractor shall furnish the copy of EPF & ESI remittance challans of the previous month towards contribution of EPF & ESI for their employees engaged in Road Milk Tankers along with the second fortnight bill. Without this proof, the second fortnight bill will not be accepted. If the Contractor had not registered under the EPF Act, and ESI Act or not furnished the proof of remittance of EPF & ESI, the Union shall recover the EPF & ESI

contribution from the contractor bills. The contractor shall furnish all the required information and documents whenever the Federation calls for the above purpose. If any liability devolves on the Federation because of the failure of the contractor in implementing any law, the contractor shall make good the loss and pay damages to the Federation.

d) The Contractor should furnish the following details of his employees to the office for records:

- Aadhaar card
- PAN Card
- Photographs.

e) UNIFORM TO VEHICLE CREW:

The contractor shall provide Khaki uniform and ID Card to the employees and it is the duty of the contractor to ensure that they wear uniform while they are on duty, failing which a penalty of Rs.500.00 per day per employee will be recovered from the claims

4.35. PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN WHILE SUBMITTING THE DOCUMENTS:

1. Tender forms containing over- written rates, erased rates and rates not shown in words will be rejected.
2. In case of discrepancy in rates as shown in figures, and in words, the tender accepting authority will take the lower of the two.
3. The tenderer shall sign in every page of the tender document and shall ensure the document is complete in all respects.

4. The tenderer must satisfy himself thoroughly about the geographical area to be covered, nature of work, local conditions and the requirement of the Federation before submitting his tender.
5. The person signing the tender should be the Proprietor / Partner / Managing Director or any other person duly authorized to sign the tender document. In the latter case, authorization letter should be attached.

4.36. BLACKLISTED APPLICANTS:

If the tenderer has already been blacklisted by any Government/ Government Under takings/ Other Unions of the Federation/ Federation/Co – Operative societies, his tender will be rejected. In case information about such black listing comes to the knowledge of the Federation after awarding of the tender, the contract will be terminated, liquidated damages levied, apart from taking penal action.

4.37. VALIDITY OF PRICE TENDER:

The tender offer shall be kept for acceptance for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of Part – I Technical bid. The offers with lower validity period are liable for rejection.

4.38. DEVIATION FROM TENDER CONDITIONS:

- a). The offers of the tenderers with deviations on technical / commercial terms of the tender will be rejected.
- b). No alternate offer will be accepted.
- c). Conditional offer will be rejected.

4.39 DISQUALIFICATION CLAUSE: Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- a) Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
- b) Record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.; and/or
- c) Participated in the previous bidding for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high bid prices and could not furnish rational justification to the employer.
- d) Those tenderers who have been blacklisted by other unions and the period of such blacklisting is in force during the tender evaluation period are deemed to be disqualified from participating in the tender.

4.40. MISCELLANEOUS:

- a) The Joint Managing Director of the Federation reserves the right to add, subtract and modify any terms and conditions of the agreement with the consent of the Contractor during the contract period.
- b) The Federation reserves right to accept or reject any or all tenders, retender or cancel the tender as per provisions of TNTT Act and Rules.
- c) Quality of service and time are the essence of the tender. The time schedule for the operation of RMTs, will be given by the Union for which applied for and the RMTs should be operated scrupulously following the time schedule, as any delay in same would cause loss, damage and impairment of quality of milk supplied by the Union.

- f) The tankers will be permitted for operation as per Motor Vehicles Act and Rules.

The tenderer should submit valid documents to prove his experience in transporting milk.

5.3. Xerox copy of Pan card shall be submitted along with tender documents.

5.4. The Age of the tanker which is provided for the purpose of transportation of milk as per the tender should be in road worthy condition and its age must be 12 years as on the date of publication of notice inviting tender. The age of the vehicle will be calculated from the date of first registration of the RMT.

5.5. The tenderer who are downloading the document from the web site are instructed to check the web site for corrigendum after the date of pre-bid

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

- 1) The milk tanks of RMTs shall be of stainless steel conforming to BIS specification (inner shell – AISI 304 Grade). It should keep the milk without spoilage. The RMT should be insulated to ensure that the temperature raise limit shall not be more than 2°C in 24 hours during transportation.
